Coming this Summer, Microsoft plans to release the next version of the Windows OS, version 10. Microsoft also [recently announced](#) that they will be phasing out Internet Explorer in this version of the operating system, being replaced by a new browser that is currently being code-named 'Spartan'. Internet Explorer 11 is expected to be released alongside Spartan on the new OS, but going forward, the focus will be on Spartan. Spartan is available for preview now as part of early releases of Windows 10.

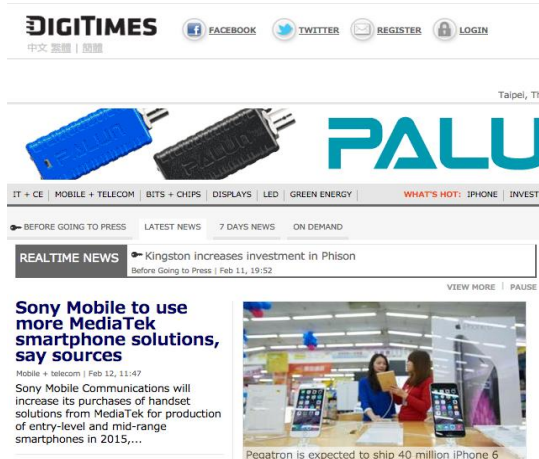

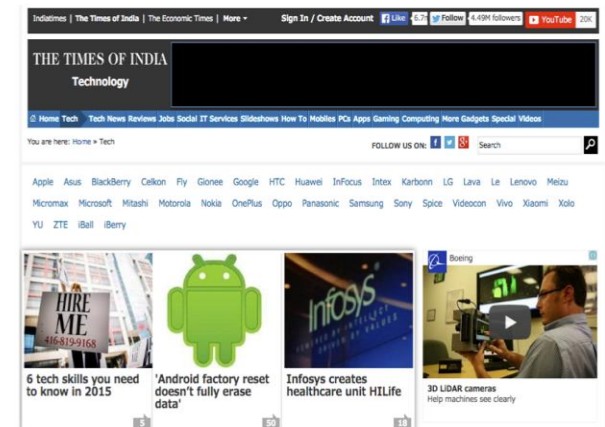

WASHINGTON, Feb 12 — The millions of people using dating apps on company smartphones could be exposing themselves and their employers to hacking, spying and theft, according to a study by International Business Machines Corp. IBM security researchers said 26 of 41 dating apps they analyzed on Google Inc's Android mobile platform had medium or high severity vulnerabilities, in a report published yesterday. 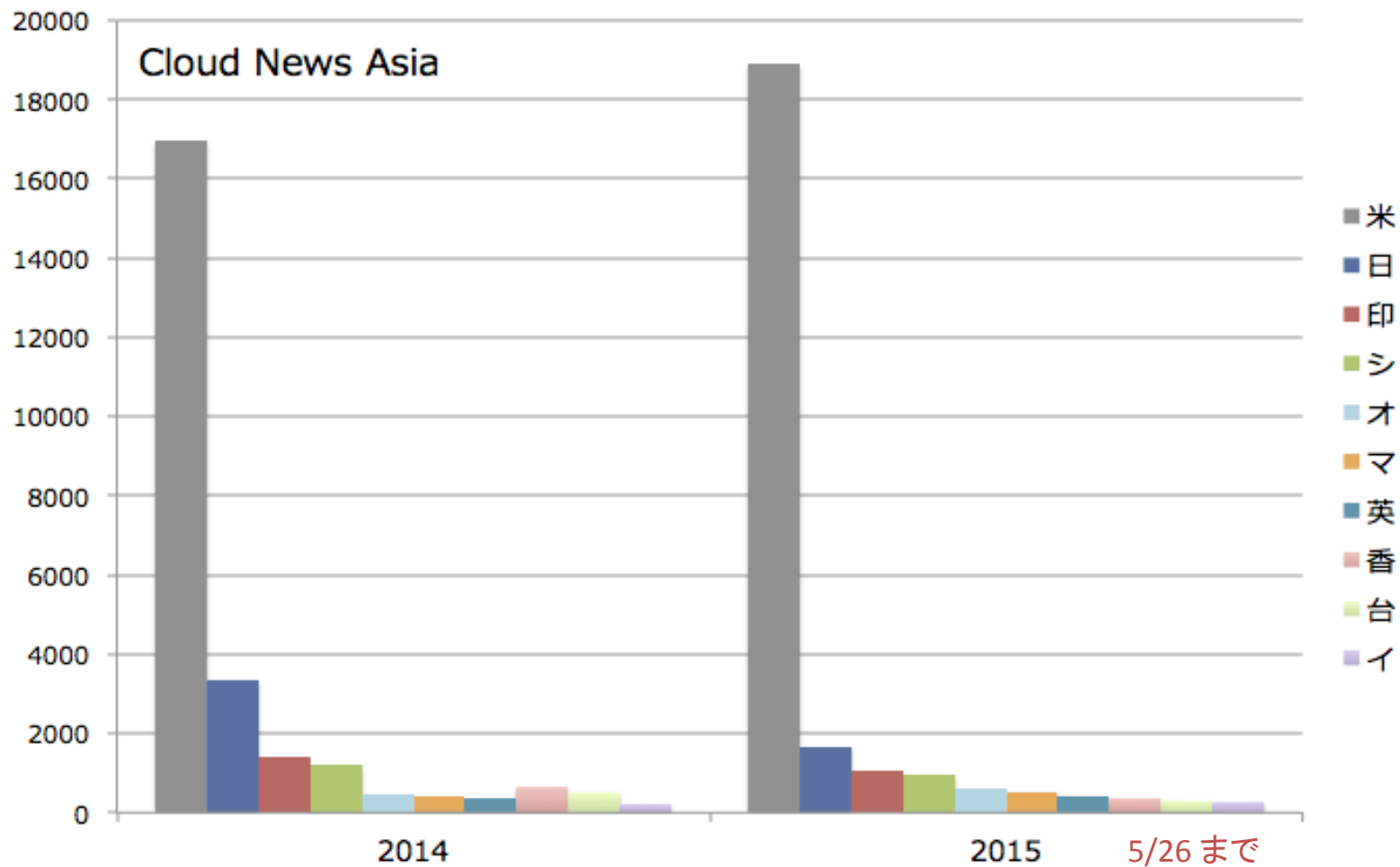

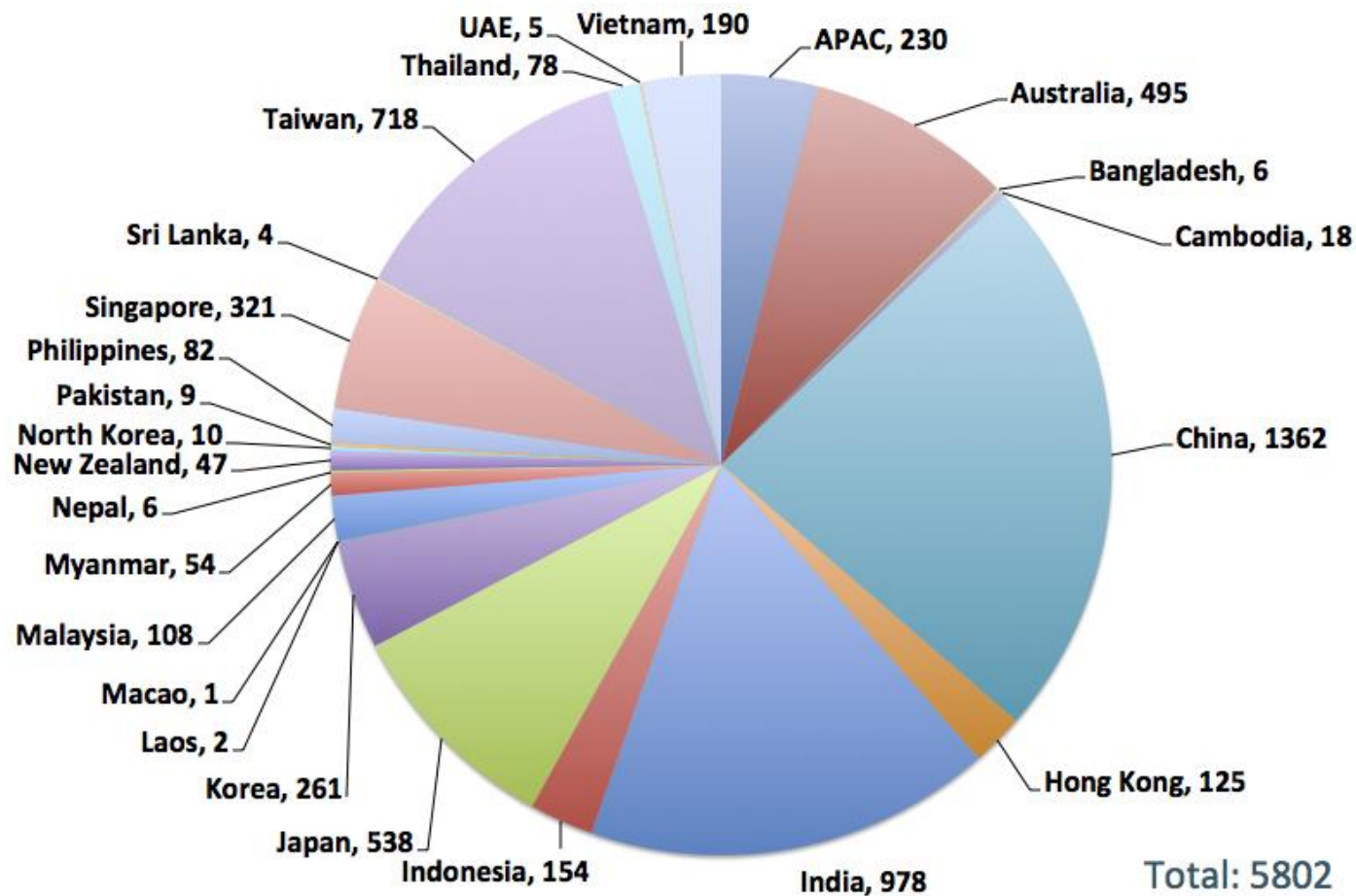

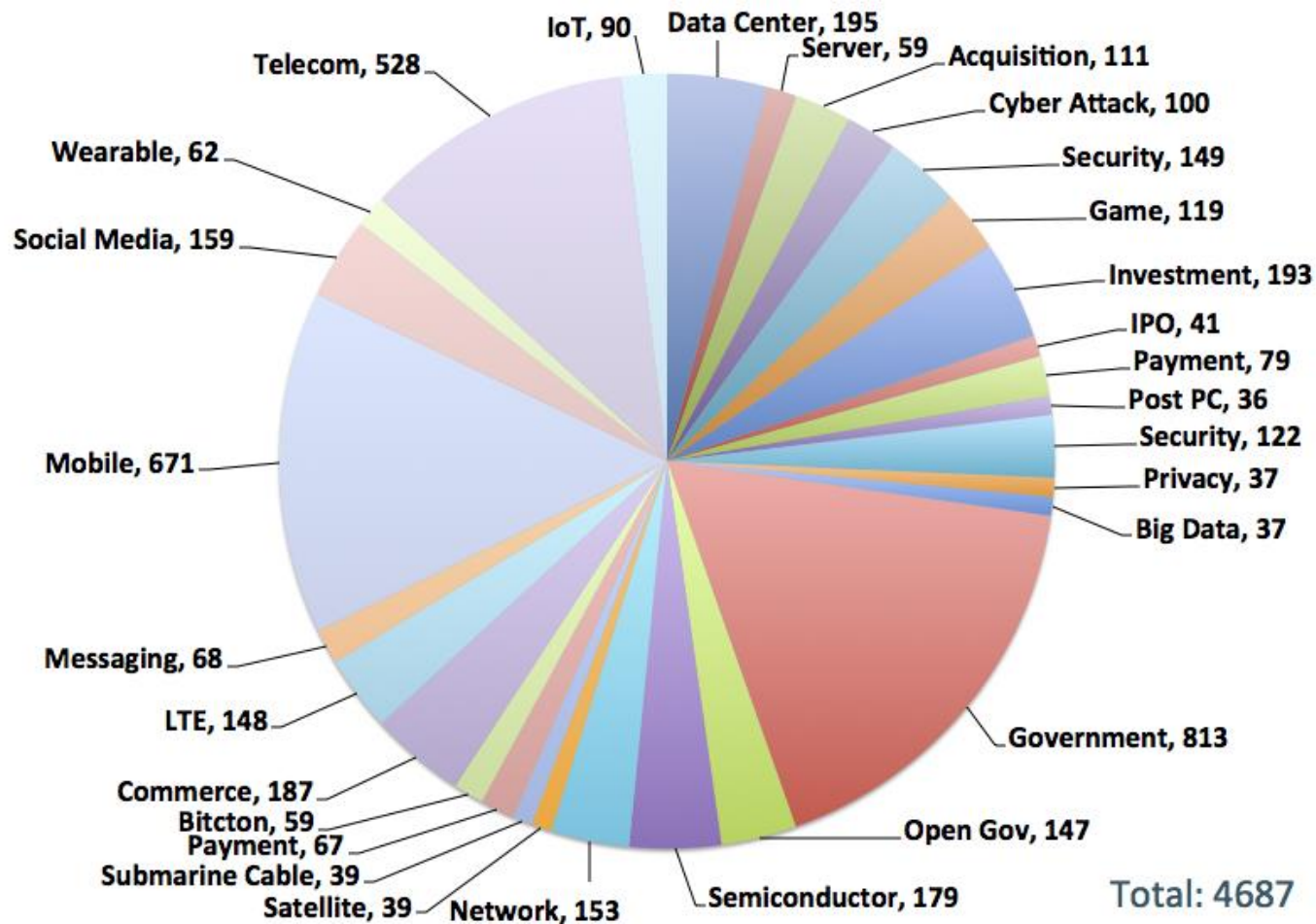

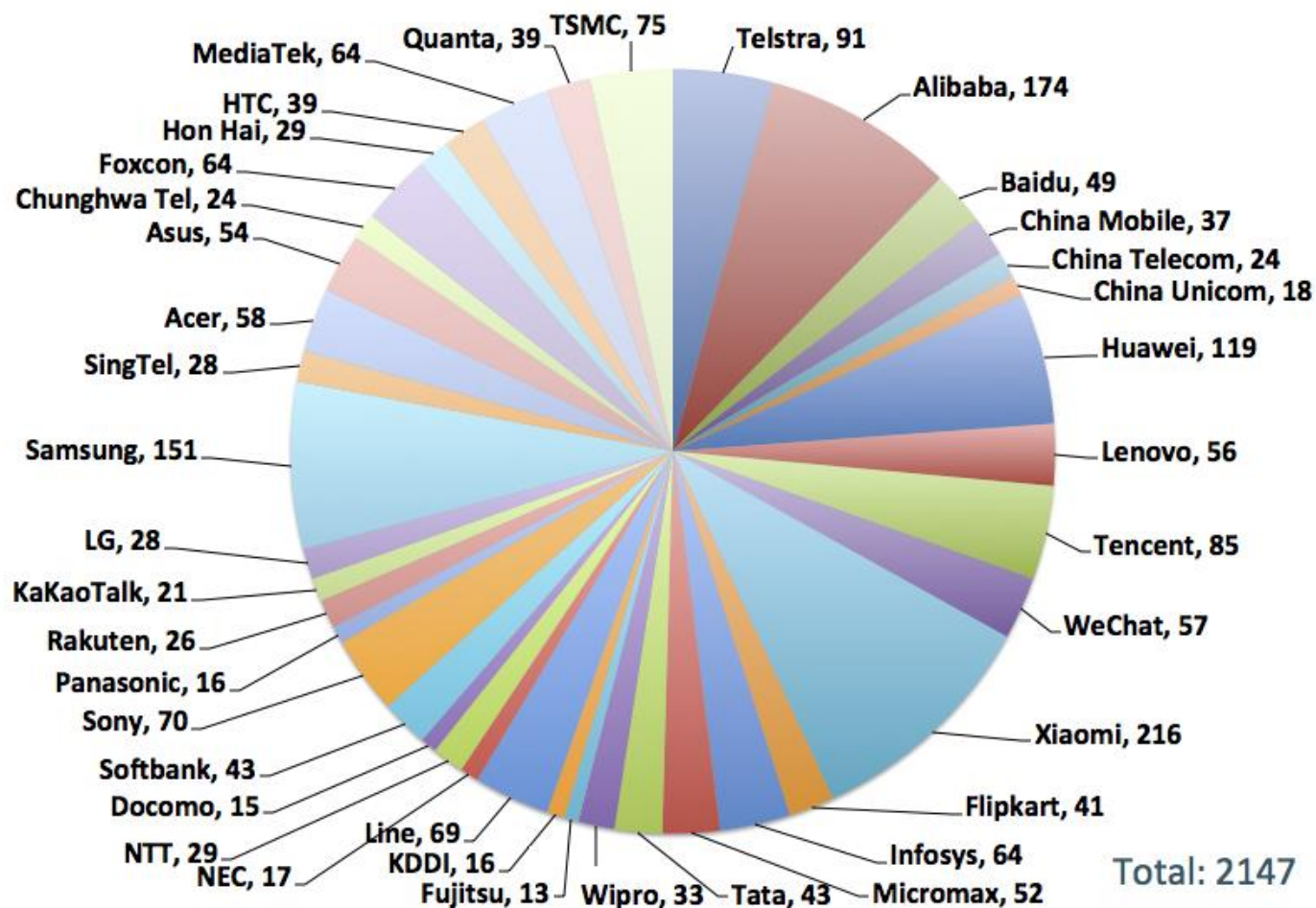
国別 トピックス比率

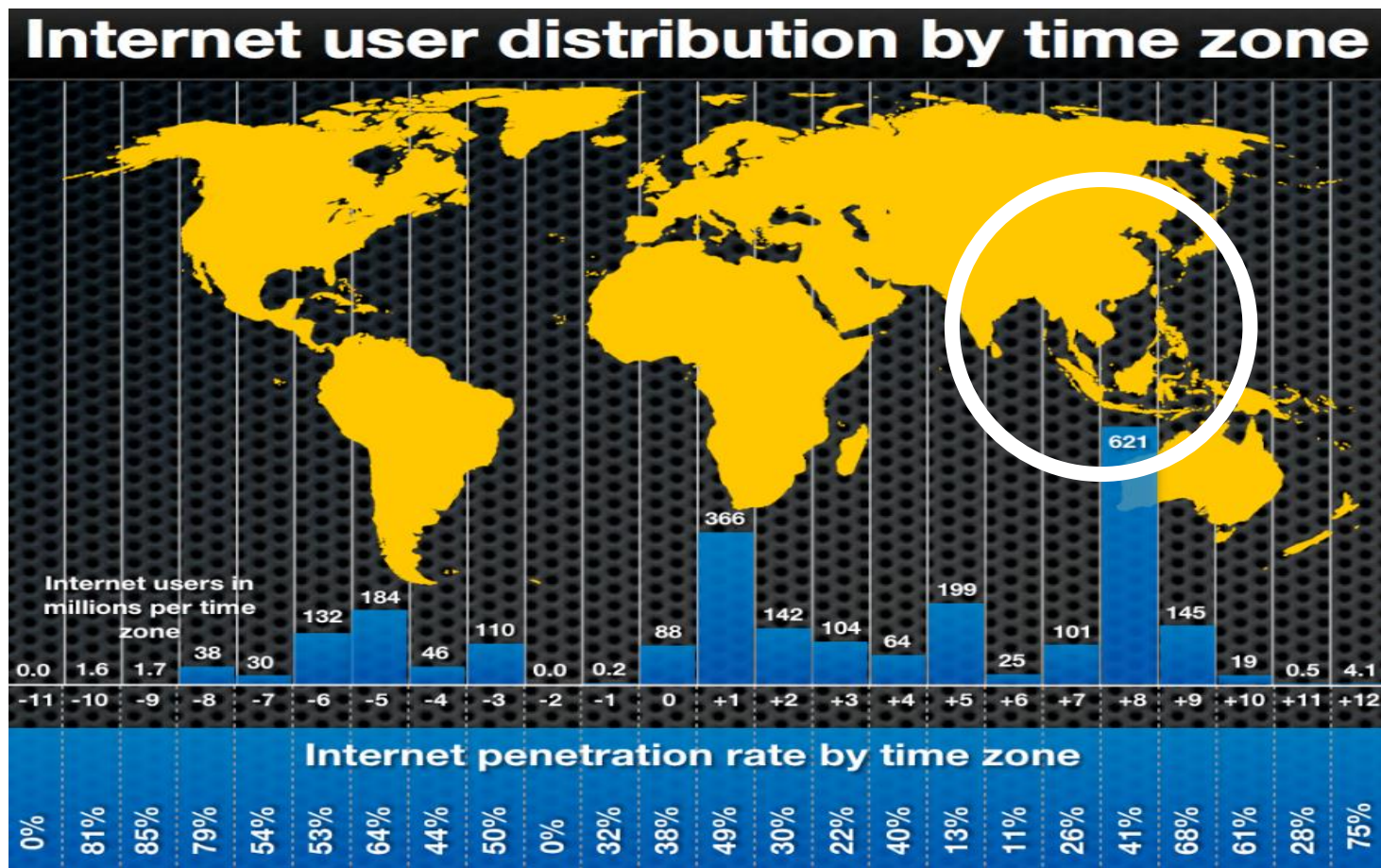

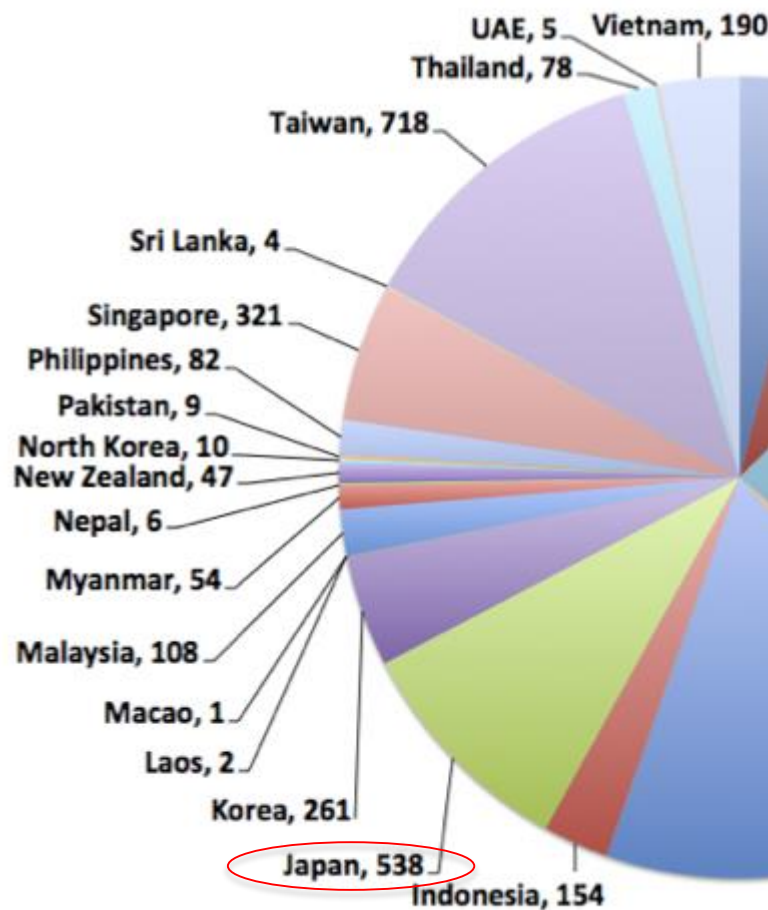

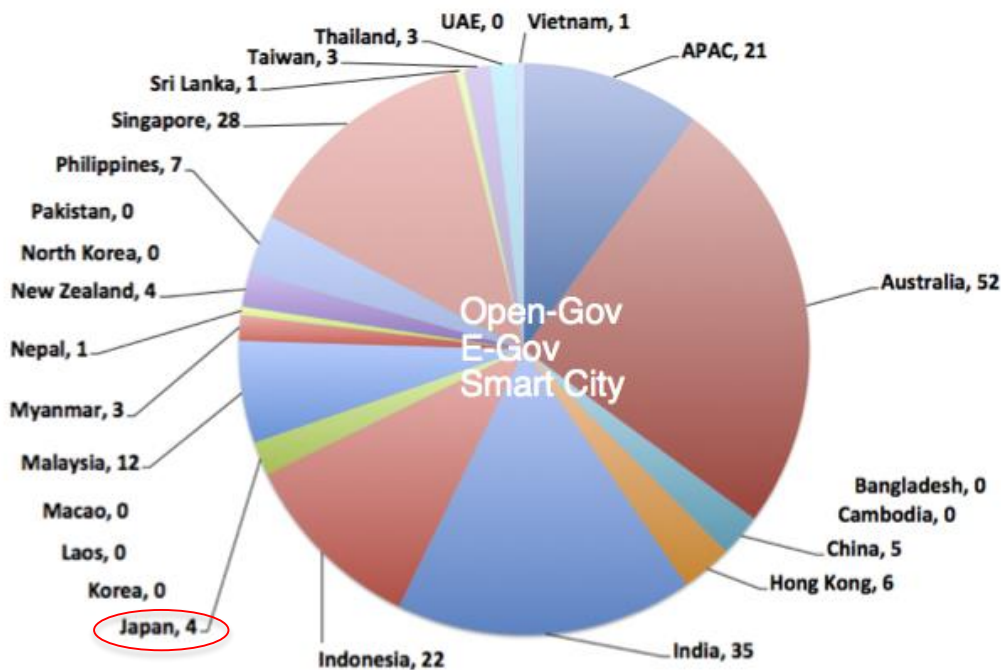
